Samenvatting	<p>When the issue of context is raised it is typically argued that the focal event cannot be properly understood, interpreted appropriately, or described in a relevant fashion, unless one looks beyond the event itself to other phenomena (for example cultural setting, speech situation, shared background assumptions) within the event is embedded, or alternatively that features of talk itself invoke particular background assumptions relevant to the organization of subsequent interaction. The context is thus a frame that surrounds the event being examined and provides resources for its appropriate interpretation.</p> <p>The notion of context thus involves a fundamental juxtaposition of two entities: (1) a focal event; and (2) a field of action within which that event is embedded.</p> <p>About context in language</p>
